Reports:

- A. Secretary's** minutes were approved as submitted
- B. Treasurer's** Report submitted by Tim, accepted as submitted
- C. Literature Report:** Georgia reported no change; however, she is anticipating having new pieces of literature coming from oa.org
- D. E. Next Gen:** Jessica thanked Dee for the TikTok videos and Dee reported that the TikTok account has over 300 followers and over 1,000 "likes"
- E. TSW:** Christie reported on planning developments for the Fall Retreat. Her committee has met and are developing suggested ideas. A very tentative framework is being looked at with spurts of recovery activities/speakers with 1.5-2 hour breaks in between...it may look something like this: 9-11- speaker/activities, 1-3- speaker/activities and 4:30-5:30 wrap up event. The theme is addressing: How do we fill the hole when we really want to eat? Ways to pass time when food is calling, Cultivating Calm for the Hungry Soul. Lots of good ideas are percolating, the date is yet to be determined, but is expected to occur in mid October to early November. The possibility of combining it with a Trifecta focus is being considered.

- G. Newsletter-** Dee reported the publication of the July newsletter and the reviews are very positive.
