Service Position Open in January 2027	Brief Description of Duties and Other Information	Abstinence Requirement
*VICE CHAIR	Support the chairperson and ensure continuity of leadership and committee function. Serve in place of the Chairperson when needed. This is an OACFI Board Position. The Vice Chair shall have given service beyond the group level for a minimum of 1 year. Term of services is 2 years. The vice chair is usually expected to become chair.	1 year
*TREASURER	Manage the financial resources of the Intergroup in accordance with established policies, and maintain its fiscal integrity. Provide regular financial reports, including prudent reserve status. This is an OACFI Board Position. Treasurer shall have given service beyond the group level for a minimum of 1 year. Term of service is 2 years.	1 year
*PIPO (PUBLIC INFORMATION AND PROFESSIONAL OUTREACH) COMMITTEE CHAIR	The PIPO Committee shall carry the Overeaters Anonymous message to the public and professional community and support efforts to increase public awareness of Overeaters Anonymous. Recommended term of service is 2 years.	6 months
*NEWSLETTER EDITOR	Produce the Intergroup newsletter in support of communication and recovery. The newsletter currently comes out monthly. Recommended term of service is 2 years.	6 months
*12TH STEP WITHIN COMMITTEE CHAIR	Support recovery within the fellowship by reaching members who still suffer.	6 months
*REGION 8 ASSEMBLY REPRESENTATIVES (2 OPENINGS)	Represent the Intergroup at Region 8 Assemblies. Attend and participate in Region 8 Assemblies. Present a written report to Intergroup following the assembly. There are two (2) Business Assemblies / Recovery Conventions per year; usually held in March and October. Term of service is 2 years. Service-related expenses are covered by Intergroup.	6 months
*WORLD SERVICE DELEGATES (3 OPENINGS)	Represent the Intergroup at the World Service Business Conference. Attend and participate in the World Service Business Conference. Present a written report to Intergroup following the conference. The World Service Business Conference meets every year. Term of service is 2 years. Service-related expenses are covered by Intergroup. OA World Service states that each Delegate shall have given service beyond the group level for a minimum of 2 years.	1 year
*NEXT GENERATION COMMITTEE CHAIR	Support outreach and engagement with younger people in Overeaters Anonymous. Recommended term of service is 2 years.	6 months
*INTERGROUP MEETING REPRESENTATIVES Needed for groups that do not currently have a Meeting Representative for Intergroup.	Serve as the link between member groups and the Intergroup. Attend and participate in the Intergroup business meetings. Communicate information, motions, and decisions between Intergroup and their group. Ensure their group's meeting information is accurate and current. Support Intergroup service through committee participation, where possible. Appoint an alternate who may serve in their absence. Intergroup meets monthly via videoconferencing.	Not listed.
